The Organization

The mission of Education for the Arts (EFA) is to enhance arts education for all students in Kalamazoo County by making dance, literary arts, media arts, music, theater, and visual arts an essential part of comprehensive education.

Education for the Arts, modeled on the educational approach of Lincoln Center Institute, is a program of Kalamazoo Regional Education Service Agency (KRESA). EFA is based on a unanimous desire of the nine public school districts in Kalamazoo County to make arts education a learning and teaching priority. EFA's mandate is to enhance arts education opportunities and programs for all Kalamazoo County schools through developing, maintaining, and strengthening partnerships between school districts, buildings, and teachers and the rich array of professional arts institutions in Southwest Michigan. Education for the Arts has two major program areas: Excellence in the Arts (arts classes offered for high-school credit to students in Kalamazoo County) and Arts for All (artist residency and exposure programs for students in grades K-8).
